



Ethics Classes at Padstow Park Public School

Dear Parents and Carers,

Our school is commencing the introduction of Special Ethics Education (SEE) in Term 1 this year. Ethics classes are being offered as an option for children who do not attend Special Religious Education (SRE) Scripture. The NSW government has authorised the charity, Primary Ethics, to create curriculum and deliver these classes, which are provided free.

Trained and authorised volunteer Ethics Teachers lead discussions. Classes are inquiry-based and children use dialogue and discussion to learn how to think about ethical matters through the give-and-take of reasoned argument.

Topics the children in different age groups may cover include:

Empathy, Being similar and being different, Fairness, Good reasons, Understanding the rules, Disagreeing respectfully, Moral responsibility, and Are some things just wrong.

Places are limited, but we will try to accommodate as many children as possible. Primary Ethics is committed to recruiting additional ethics teachers through the course of the year in order to provide for any children who may miss out initially.
