Kindergarten Orientation and Staffing

At this stage we have 56 kindergarten students for 2018. This means we will stay with our current set up of 13 mainstream classes and one IM class. Our numbers at present are fluctuating on a weekly basis. We hope to stabilise over the next few weeks. Week 1 2018 classes can expect to stay in their 2017 location. This allows the school to calculate the return of students and to settle student movement in classes.

Transition to Stage 1 and 2

Transition workshops have been well received in the past. We are running these information workshops again for parents of student who are moving into Year 1 and Year 3. The information evenings will present information on expectations, homework and home reading as well helpful hints for making the transitions as smooth as possible into a new learning environment.

Online Payments

There is a red box in the front office, where parents and students can post cash and/ or cheque payments to save waiting at the counter. These schools help gifted and talented students to learn by grouping them with other gifted and talented students, teaching them in specialised ways and providing educational materials at the appropriate level.

School Banking


School banking is each Thursday morning in E block. If you would like to volunteer your time to help out with school banking please see the volunteers for details.
